2014 - 2015 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION FORM

Welcome! The goal of the Religious Education programs at our parish collaborative is to provide students with an opportunity to receive formal religious education which will assist in the formation of their faith and values. Specific areas which guide the achievement of this goal are: prayer, the sacraments, scripture, doctrine, and service. Our programs exist to support parents/guardians who are the primary educators of their children through their own word and example. Active participation by parents is vital to the reinforcement of what is taught in the classroom, as we provide a curriculum and activities that will build upon the faith values that you share with your child(ren) at home.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. You must be a registered member of either St. Agnes or St. Rose to enroll your child in one of our Religious Education programs.
2. Children must be re-registered *each year*.
3. Registration begins on **April 10, 2014** and ends on **May 23, 2014**.
4. Religious Education teachers are guaranteed their first choice of class day and time.
5. Each completed application will be given preference based on date and time received.
6. Class size is limited to 12 students.
7. Baptismal certificates are required for all 1st, 2nd & 10th grade students who were not baptized at either St. Agnes or St. Rose.
