GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. You must be a registered member of either St. Agnes or St. Rose to enroll your child in one of our Religious Education programs.
- 2. Children must be re-registered *each year*.
- 3. Registration begins on April 10, 2014 and ends on May 23, 2014.
- 4. Religious Education teachers are guaranteed their first choice of class day and time.
- 5. Each completed application will be given preference based on date and time received.
- 6. Class size is limited to 12 students.
- 7. Baptismal certificates are required for all 1st, 2nd & 10th grade students who were not baptized at either St. Agnes or St. Rose.
